Dear Colts Neck Parent / Guardian,

We are providing this notification consistent with the district's Safe Return Plan.

The district has received notice of an individual who tested positive for COVID. This case is at Conover Road Primary School and is currently under investigation by county and local health officials. All school-related close contacts associated with these cases were notified and must quarantine at home in accordance with the current New Jersey Department of Health's quarantine timeframe for close contacts. Individual privacy and confidentiality restrictions prevent us from sharing specific details about this individual.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) defines a close contact as an individual who is within 6 feet of someone with suspected or known COVID-19 for 15 or more minutes during a 24-hour period. In certain situations, it may be difficult to determine whether individuals have met this criterion and an entire cohort, classroom, or other groups may need to be considered exposed. **EXCEPTION** (updated August 2021): In the K–12 indoor classroom setting, the close contact definition excludes students who were within 3 to 6 feet of an infected student (laboratory-confirmed or a clinically compatible illness) where both the infected student and the exposed student(s) correctly and consistently wore well-fitting masks the entire time. This exception does not apply to teachers, staff, or other adults in the indoor classroom setting.

The district's *Safe Return Plan* was designed with the anticipation that cases could sporadically arise.
