IT'S ALMOST TIME FOR THE START OF THE 2023-2024 SCHOOL YEAR!

On behalf of the entire staff here at the Colts Neck Township Schools, please allow me to officially welcome you and your family to the 2023-2024 school year! As a reminder, the first day of school for students is **Wednesday**, **September 6**, **2023**.

OFFICIAL OPENING OF THE GENESIS PARENT PORTAL

Beginning 9:00 AM tomorrow, Friday, August 25, 2023, after logging into the Genesis Parent Portal, and <u>before</u> gaining access to your child(ren)'s 2023-2024 homeroom(s) and transportation information, you will be required to read, acknowledge, and complete all annual parent forms. Thank you, in advance, for your anticipated attention and cooperation with completing these forms. Additionally, for parents/guardians of students entering grades 3-8, please be sure to pay your child(ren)'s Technology User Fee by September 15, 2023. Payments can be made through PaySchools or by delivering a check made out to "Colts Neck Township Schools" to the Business Office, located in the Administration Building.

In preparation for our new school year together, please allow me to share the following important and helpful information:

NEW in 2023-2024 ~ COLTS NECK PARENTS ACADEMY:

For the 23-24 school year, the district is developing a "Colts Neck Parents Academy". The Parents Academy will invite our parents/guardians to participate in a series of programs throughout the school year designed specifically for our parents. Topics for sessions will include Internet Safety, Google Classroom for Parents, Substance Awareness, AND MUCH MORE. We are even planning for student and parent panel discussions. After the start of the school year, will receive a separate email invitation to our Parents Academy with detailed information about the schedule and list of session topics. We hope you will be able to join us!

NEW in 2023-2024 ~ REVISED K-5 REPORT CARDS AND TRIMESTER MARKING PERIODS:

Effective this school year, K-5 students will be assessed on a trimester schedule. Additionally, for K-5 students, the district will be using a new report card that includes a revised design and expanded categories for teachers to use when communicating with parents about academic performance and personal growth. The new report card includes:

- New Jersey Student Learning Standards (NJSLS)
- All subject/content areas
- Clarifications for expectations and performance levels
- Consistent performance indicators for academic areas, K-5

• Personal and Social Development as well Executive Functioning skills

In the near future, Dr. Erica Reynolds, Colts Neck Twp. Schools' Director of Curriculum and Instruction, will be sending a detailed letter to our K-5 parents/guardians about the district's new K-5 new report card. District Chain of Communication:

The district has a Chain of Communication designed to assist parents/guardians with identifying the appropriate sequence to use when seeking an answer to a question or resolution to a concern. We understand that when contacting the district, it may be frustrating to be redirected to someone else; however, many questions and concerns are able to be answered or resolved first by your child's teacher or appropriate staff with oversight of your child's program. Therefore, as a parent/guardian you are encouraged to start all inquiries with your child's teacher(s). If your question or concern remains unresolved by your child's teacher, the Chain of Communication identifies the appropriate channel through which communications can be elevated. Colts Neck Township Schools Social Media Platforms:

District and School Security:

Colts Neck Township Schools prioritizes the safety and security of its students and staff. While the majority of the information related to the district's specific security plans and procedures are not public, the following information is intended to provide parents/guardians with an overview of the district's safety and security measures:

- Special Law Enforcement Officers, Class III (SLEO III) in each school, daily
- School Security Monitors: Each school has a School Security Monitor responsible for, among many things, the
 facilitation of visitor management, which includes the screening of visitors prior to gaining entry to the school
 buildings
- Security Vestibules: Each school has a secured vestibule at the front entrance that contains all visitors until access is granted by school personnel
- Critical Incident Notification (CIN) System: The district has a Critical Incident Notification System that allows
 the district to immediately alert school personnel and law enforcement of any emergency incident occurring in our
 schools
- Surveillance Cameras: The district has several surveillance cameras placed in and around school property, including buses

Each year, I genuinely look forward to September and the return of our students. After all, a school isn't truly a school without our students. As we put the finishing touches on the start of the new school year, please know that our district's website, www.coltsneckschools.org, is designed to provide parents/guardians and school community with the most current district information and resources.
